

## 2017 BMLGC WEEKLY PLAY

Tee times and signup: Morning shotgun start May 2nd. May starts will be 9:00 a.m. June through August will start at 8:00 a.m. And we will tee off at 9 a.m. during September. Evening shotgun will be 5:30 pm.

Each Tuesday arrive 30 minutes before the starting time. Chuck will make pairings at that time.

Fees: Weekly fees remain at \$5 for 18-hole players and \$3 for 9-hole players with \$1 each week going to the weekly point game. The 9-hole game pool will consist of \$2 from each player and the golfers continuing for 18 holes will have another pool of \$2 from each participant.

### Ways to Win:

1. Weekly games apply to first 9 only. Both the front nine and the back nine will be used. The schedule will be adjusted, as the pro shop deems necessary.
2. Weekly point game will be May 2 through September 26. This is based on weekly net score for the first nine holes. Points that are earned will be explained on the bulletin board.
3. Match Play and Club Championship Tournament fees will be \$10 for 18-hole players and \$5 for 9-hole players. Match Play will begin in June. The pro shop will make brackets based on those who sign-up by June 15. Players will arrange the matches for times other than regular game days. The Club Championship will be played on two consecutive days: Monday September 11<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday September 12<sup>th</sup>. Participants must be members in "good standing" and have played 7 weekly events before September 1.
4. Ringer Board (optional \$5 annual fee) The board will be ready for recording the original scores.
5. Skins (optional \$2 weekly fee) Skins will be paid to the single lowest net score and to the single lowest gross score on each hole. 18-hole players have the option of an additional \$2 fee for the second nine.
6. Hole-in-one (\$1 not an option) when a member scores a hole-in-one on Ladies Day, she will immediately receive the whole amount in the Hole-in-One Account. All members will be required to pay \$1 each to reestablish the account.
7. Birdies and Chip-ins are recognized, so please note them on the scorecard... If you don't tell us, we don't know.

### Reminders:

1. Check in 30 minutes before starting tee time for pairings to be made.
2. Count all strokes...even whiffs. Putt out all holes...no give-mes. Pick up when score totals 12.
3. Be considerate of others, put cell phones on vibrate.
4. Keep play moving along.
5. The pro shop will post our Ladies Day scores, but we are responsible for posting all of our other scores throughout the season! Accurate handicaps make the game more fun for everyone.
