

## 2024 BMLGC WEEKLY PLAY

Tee times and signup: Morning shotgun starts May 7<sup>th</sup> through September 3<sup>rd</sup> at 8:30 am. Evening shotgun will be at 5:00 p.m. for the entire season.

### **SIGN UP EACH WEEK BY SATURDAY NOON TO PLAY ON TUESDAY**

#### **Ways to win:**

1. Weekly games are nine holes. We will alternate playing front and back courses unless adjusted as necessary per Battlement Mesa Golf Course management personnel.
2. The point games will run from May 14<sup>th</sup> through August 27<sup>th</sup>. How points are earned is explained on the BMLCG bulletin board. Weekly costs are \$2.00 ( non-postable games such as a Scramble) or \$5.00 (\$2.00 towards the game, \$2.00 for Skins Gross & Net winners and \$1.00 Season point awards).
3. Match Play will begin in June **if** at least 8 members sign up to play by **June 15, 2024**. Pro Shop will make brackets based on those who sign-up. Match Play fee is \$10.00.
4. The Club Championship will be determined by an 18-hole total score played on September 10 (front 9) and September 17 (back 9). Competitors must play both weeks to be eligible for Club Championship. Entry fee is \$10.00.
5. Ringer Board (optional \$5 annual fee). The 1<sup>st</sup> postable scores of the season on Front and Back will be entered on the board in ink by the BMLGC Secretary. Players will then update lower scores per hole in pencil on the Ringer Board. Ringer Board "Season purse" will be distributed to those with the most improved scores.
6. Skins will be paid to the **single** lowest **net** score and the **single** lowest **gross** score on each hole during applicable games. If no winners, "Weekly purse" rolls over to the following week.
7. Hole-in-One (\$1 required). When a member scores a hole-in-one on Ladies Day, she immediately receives the entire amount in the Hole-in-one account and all members will be required to pay another \$1 to reestablish the fund.
8. BMLGC recognizes Birdies and Chip-ins scored on weekly postable game days and excludes tournaments and special events played such as Match Play and Championship. Note birdies and chip-ins on your scorecard, Ringer Board & BMLGC Bulletin board. If you don't tell us, we won't know.....

#### **Reminders:**

1. Check in at Pro Shop 30 minutes before tee time.
2. Count **all** strokes...even whiffs. Putt out all holes...no gimmes. Pick up at 12 Strokes unless competition includes low putts; upon reaching 12 strokes place your ball at furthest point on the green from hole and then putt out.
3. Put cell phones on vibrate during the game.
4. Keep up pace of play.
5. The Pro Shop will post Ladies Day scores.
6. Post all additional scores played throughout the season to maintain an accurate handicap.
